PAINTS (Artist grade)

Recommended Colors: Permanent Rose, Cadmium Yellow Light or Aureolin, Cobalt or Cerulean Blue, Viridian, Dioxazine purple, Cadmium Orange.

A couple of my other favorites are: Quinacridone Gold, Ultramarine and Prussian Blue, Scarlet Lake and Sap Green *

BRUSHES

I prefer a synthetic/sable blend but there are some good synthetics out there such as Loew Cornell Ultra Rounds* and Beste.brushes

WATERCOLOR PAPER* 140 lb. cold press and Yupo. Multiple pieces of paper for each class. We will use Yupo during the final class.

Sketchbook

Holbein Spray Bottle

Blow Dryer

Additional mark making materials will be discussed during class.

**Buy the best materials that you can afford. I typically use Arches or Fabriano paper. An artist grade paint will give you the best results. I use Winsor Newton (not Cotman), Holbein, Turner, Lukas (Jerrysartorama.com) and American Journey (CheapJoes.com)*

CLASS LINKS: For security, **after** a student clicks any link in the document they receive upon enrollment, they have **24 hours** to download the product. **After 24 hours, the link will expire.** In addition: All links can now be accessed on the Class Pinterest Board.

Class Outline: All classes are project based. Students will be directed, step-by-step through the process of creating a painting over a series of weeks unless the focus is on mini, weekly projects. Due to the varying levels of watercolor experience within any given group, it is not possible for the teacher to supply a class outline.

Cancelled Classes: If it is necessary for the instructor to cancel a class, all students will be notified via email. The current class session will be extended by one week to facilitate a make-up class unless indicated otherwise.

Missed Classes: There are no refunds for missed classes.

Class Etiquette: Students should mute their mics upon entering class but are allowed and encouraged to unmute themselves should they care to ask a question or make a comment. If necessary, the instructor may mute all attendees. Students may enable or disable their cameras at their own discretion.

Class Recordings: An unedited recording of each class will be made available to enrolled students for 60 days from the completion of class. The link for viewing this recording will be posted in the group Pinterest board within 2 hours after class has ended.
